You could find below the informational report of Events Commission for the 2021 4th FIDE Council Meeting.

FIDE EVE World Championships Calendar for 2022:

Events commission is working on to update the calendar of 2022 by communicating with organizers. We are willing that all FIDE EVE World Championships in the calendar shall be organized in 2022 without postponement hoping pandemic situation wouldn't interfere.

FIDE-ISF World School Online Chess Cup 2022

FIDE and ISF signed a MOU and EVE is working with ISF for the organization of the online school cup which is scheduled for February 2022.

FIDE World Junior U22 Online Chess Championship 2022

FIDE EVE working on organizing FIDE World U22 Junior Online Cup 2022 in March 2022 with the organization of Sri Lanka Chess federation and working together with the President of Sri Lanka Chess Federation Luxman Wijesuriya.

FIDE Handbook Task Force

EVE is participating actively in the work of task force and meetings related with different issues.

Updated IO Titles Regulations

Updated IO Titles and Seminars Regulations were submitted for the approval of FIDE MB and FIDE Council.

Synergy with FIDE Commissions

EVE is working closely with different commissions, to name some of them:

- GSC** – FIDE Calendar, Bidding form and procedures, General regulations
- MED** – Issue of pandemic measures for OTB tournaments for 2022
- FPL** – Issue of fair-play measures for OTB and Online tournaments for 2022

International Organizer (IO) Seminars:

IO Seminar organized by IPCA in Torrevjeja, Spain

IPCA (International Physically Disabled Chess Association) – FIDE Affiliated Organization and co-organized by FIDE Events' Commission (EVE) organized International Organizers FIDE Seminar which was held during the 20th IPCAWORLD INDIVIDUAL CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP 2021.

The seminar was given in the English language (with translation to Russian language) by FIDE EVE Lecturer IO Olexandr Prohorov (UKR).

Successful Seminar attendees below were granted with a FIDE IO Norm which is necessary for the FIDE IO title application.

Four (4) Participants from 3 Federations (POL,RUS, ISR) attended the Seminar. All Four (4) attendees attempted to pass an exam. Four (4) persons successfully passed the exam, having achieved a score of 80% or more.

IO Seminar organized by North America Chess Hub (being held from Dec 11 to Dec 19)
