VI International Chess Tournament San Cristóbal de La Laguna 2024

Rules

Game System:

The tournament will be played using the Swiss System over 9 rounds, from August 24th to August 31st, 2024.

Venue:

The tournament will take place at the halls of the old Convent of Santo Domingo, Calle Santo Domingo 7 - 38207 - San Cristóbal de La Laguna, Tenerife - Canary Islands - Spain.

Schedule:

Games start at 5:00 PM except for rounds 2, which start at 10:00 AM, and round 9, which starts at 9:30 AM. The closing ceremony will commence on August 31st at 2:00 PM.

The international Open will be valid for the Canary Islands International Circuit. The international Blitz tournament will be held on Friday, August 23rd, starting at 7:30 PM. The international Rapid tournament, valid for the Canary Islands Rapid Circuit, will take place on August 31st and September 1st.

Initial Ranking:

FIDE Elo ratings will be considered, and in the absence of one, alphabetical order will be used. Participants must verify their personal information, Elo ratings, and codes before the

tournament begins. The tournament is valid for International Norms and FIDE Rating Evaluation.

Game Pace, Pairings, and Draw Agreements:

The time control will be 90 minutes plus 30 seconds increment per move (Fischer system). Pairings and tiebreaks will be managed using the Swiss Manager software. Draw agreements cannot be made before 30 moves or one hour of play without the referee's consent.

No-shows:

Players have a 30-minute grace period for their match presentations (time counted from the official start time of each round). A player who does not show up for the start of the first round may be replaced by another participant and will be excluded from the tournament. Players who lose a game due to absence and fail to justify it to the organization will be disqualified from the tournament. Two absences, justified or not, will result in elimination from the tournament.

Bye/Rest Requests:

Each player has the opportunity to request two byes during the tournament, valid for the first six rounds, for which half a point will be awarded, and the requester will not be paired. Requests must be made explicitly to the chief arbiter of the tournament before the start of the preceding round. A player who has committed absence forfeits the right to request a bye. Invited players cannot avail themselves of this opportunity.

Tiebreaks:

The following tiebreak systems will be applied:

- a) Direct encounter, to decide the champion of each group.
- b) Recursive Performance.
- c) Buchholz minus the 2 worst results.
- d) Number of wins.

Moves must be recorded on the scoresheets as clearly and legibly as possible, in algebraic notation. It is mandatory to record all moves with this time control. A player may respond to their opponent's move before recording it if they wish to do so. They must record their previous move before making another one. Players are obligated to hand in the original signed scoresheet with the correct result to the arbiter at the end of the game. After finishing the game, players must place the pieces back in their original position.

Playing Hall and Electronic Devices:

Analysis or reproduction of games in the playing hall is not allowed. Leaving the playing hall during a game without the referee's permission is prohibited. Unless expressly authorized by the referee, the use or possession of any communication device, mobile phone, tablet, smartwatch, etc., is prohibited in the playing hall (including bathrooms) during games. If a player is found to be connected or using an electronic communication device, they will automatically lose the game and be disqualified from the tournament. Appropriate behavior for participation in this tournament requires respect for the facilities, appropriate attire, and no consumption or dispersal of food or beverages in the playing hall. Any offensive behavior, verbal or otherwise, towards another player, referees, organizers, or the public will result in immediate disqualification from the tournament.

Players:

Participation is open to all federated players during the 2024 season. Players must be federated. The VI San Cristóbal de La Laguna International Chess Tournament 2024 will be official and valid for FIDE Elo and Norms.

Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded in strict order of classification including tiebreaks. General prizes will be awarded first, followed by local prizes and finally prizes by Elo rating and age range. In case a player qualifies for more than one prize, they will receive the one with the highest value. All prizes will be subject to the tax withholding established by current legislation. Players who win a prize must be present at the closing ceremony of the International Open; otherwise, they will forfeit their right to the prize.

The sub10 category includes those born in 2014 and later, sub12 those born in 2012 and later, sub14 those born in 2010 and later, sub16 those born in 2008 and later, and Veterans (Supra60) those born in 1964 and earlier.

Arbitral decisions may be appealed in writing to the Competition Committee before the end of the daily playing session. Any formal complaint to the Committee must be accompanied by a deposit of 30 euros as a security bond; the refund of the bond will be subject to the Committee's decision.

This Committee will be composed of the Tournament Director and four players (2 regular and 2 substitutes), chosen from among the participants. The decisions of this Committee will be final and binding.

Final Provisions:

The tournament is governed by the FIDE Chess Laws for this type of tournament. In situations not covered by these laws or these regulations, the arbitral decisions ratified by the chief arbiter shall prevail and shall be final and unappealable.

Participation in the tournament implies full acceptance of these regulations.
