Bidding Procedure for FIDE Events Commission (EVE) Online Tournaments

1. General Regulations:

- **1.1**. Call for Bid for FIDE EVE Online event shall be announced on the official FIDE website with the exact deadline for Bid submission.
- **1.2.** Any federation member of FIDE or any organiser approved by a national federation may apply (bid) for the organization of a FIDE EVE Online event.
- **1.3.** Bid Form (see below) shall be filled in by a Bidder/Applicant. Signed and stamped copy of the Bid Form shall be sent to the FIDE Office at office@fide.com with all required documents attached by the given Bid submission deadline.
- **1.4.** Additional documents may be requested by a respective FIDE EVE for further evaluation.
- **1.5.** The Bid Evaluation Report will take into consideration the following parameters: the experience of the organizers, prize fund, organizational structure, total contribution to FIDE. The report shall be presented by FIDE EVE for an approval of FIDE Council.
- **1.6.** Once the Organiser is awarded a relevant announcement shall be made on the official FIDE website. FIDE Technical Delegate (FIDE TD) may be appointed at the same time to supervise the event on behalf of FIDE with consultation and in cooperation with respective FIDE EVE.

2. Special Regulations for FIDE EVE Online Tournaments:

- **2.1** A bid for any FIDE Competitions onwards shall include the name of a FIDE licensed International Organizer.
- **2.2** Organizers shall have been preferably had experience and organized Online tournaments with at least 200 players participated.
- **2.3** Organizers shall have been preferably organized FIDE World Events.
- **2.4** The organizers assume the obligation to participate in EVE Online Events seminars.
- **2.5** Bid Fees, Deposit fees and other regulations for specific tournaments will be announced in the Call for Bids announcement.
