

The FIDE Council recommends to the General Assembly to approve the following resolution:

The General Assembly thanks the Historical Committee for such an in-depth and detailed study and considers that it is impossible to move forward without a thorough study of the past.

The Assembly instructs FIDE Management to publish all available documents on the FIDE website for public access and discussion, as well as to send them to well-known historians and chess researchers, to check the legality of the decision took at the 1939 FIDE Congress, to instructs the Historical Committee to hold an additional meeting after three months, taking into account the feedback received, and to submit and publish an updated version of the report, and grants the Council the right to officially recognize Mr. de Muro as President of FIDE if based on the results of the public discussion, the Council will come to a conclusion about the validity of such a decision.
