




USAGE OF FUNDS BY FEDERATIONS










USAGE OF FUNDS BY CONTINENT







PDC: AMERICAN ZONAL MEETING 2022

- In the framework of the Assembly of the America Chess Confederation (FIDEAMERICA), San Jose, Costa Rica, October 1st, the PDC Chair, Mrs. Sonja Johnson and the PDC secretary Mrs. Carolina Muñoz; met with federation delegates and zone presidents in order to obtain feedback on the priority areas to be worked on in each zone.
- After the feedback, the attendance agreed in three priorities for the area: Tournaments, Women Chess and Building Capacity.
- Mr Jose Carrillo, CCA President, added 4 main areas: Technology, Youth Talents, Women Chess and Chess Material for Federations.
- Also, there was several activities or ideas of mutual collaboration between countries: Promote women in other areas beside as players, tournaments circuit which allow countries to share costs, buy digital boards in order to have more promotion and hybrid tournaments; development countries can give capacitation to less development countries, join with other organizations (not necessarily sponsors), measure goals with KPI's, strategic plan with each zones, work with countries according to their level of development, regular meetings between zones/countries in order to follow goals and share ideas, among other.
