## Dear sir Re; Proposal for amendment of the FIDE Chatter

### Article 17.6 of the FIDE Charter states:

"Presidents and delegates may only represent one Member Federation at a time and must, on the date of the meeting of the General Assembly, have either: - a citizenship or at least two years' residency of the country or territory they represent, or - at least one year experience as an office holder of this Member Federation. They must also be elected or appointed by the appropriate body of that Member Federation."

### The Lesotho Chess Federation proposes to change this to:

"17.6 Presidents and delegates may only represent the Federation for which they are registered, and must, on the date of the meeting of the General Assembly, have either: - a citizenship or at least two years' residency of the country or territory they represent. They must also be elected or appointed by the appropriate body of that Member Federation."

### Explanation of why this amendment to the FIDE Charter is necessary:

This proposal removes the backdoor whereby foreign actors, with little or no connection to a federation, may infiltrate and hijack the vote. It also brings the Charter into alignment with the following article.

"16.6 Representation or voting by proxy is never allowed for any FIDE organ."

I hope the upcoming FIDE General Assembly finds the above in order and it gets approved.
