

PDC 2024 Approved requests (as of 1 April 2024)





REVISED FUNDING EVALUATION PROCESS







Increased visibility on funding

- Over time: from a *single year* approach to *full history*
- 360°: incl. available sources of funding (open aid package, veterans...)
- → Google Sheets database





- Pitch meetings to discuss the proposed projects with requesters
- → Kept *NextCloud* as a repository for requests and evaluation documents

Challenges



- Manual work: 3 technical environments without automation
- Tracking: complicated to follow when projects are expected to finish
- Reporting: low number of reports received in respect of the published deadlines



The key process steps remain the same

 Application / Pitch meeting / Evaluation / Payment / Execution / Reporting



Their implementation evolves for a better automation

- Visual Management migrated from Miro to Google Sheets = database automation:
 - no more need for double inputs
 - visual hints on deadlines
 - * many more Service Level data available
 - NextCloud remains as a document repository only (applications, reports, archiving of decisions) while the evaluation process is migrated to Google Sheets, with better formalised documents available for accounts & audit







Expected benefits:


- Better follow-up of requests at any stage (evaluation and execution)
