I. Revised Regulations Proposal

The Commission has been working on improving the Fair Play Regulations, which were first presented to the Council in April 2024 and sent back for improvement in July 2024:

- I.1 Fair Play Protection Measures (formerly Anti-Cheating Protection Measures)
- I.2 Financial Regulations
- I.3 Appointment Regulations
- I.4 Fair Play Regulations (formerly Anti-Cheating Regulations)

I.1 Fair Play Protection Measures (formerly Anti-Cheating Protection Measures)

This underwent major revisions with a view to easing fair play requirements and streamlining the text.

- a) Mention of the proportionality of Fair Play measures was added.
- b) A distinction between GSC and EVE events was introduced.
- c) Requirements for EVE events have been substantially reduced.
- d) A general provision for taking account of special conditions when determining the Fair Play Team has been introduced.

I.2 Financial Regulations

All Fair Play Fees have been harmonized to ARB fees.

The only difference lies with the CFPO, where the fee has been set in-between CA and DCA.

The Commission wishes to sensitize Council to the circumstance that the duties, responsibilities and workload of a CFPO are higher than those of a DCA at all events and it would be unfair to treat them financially at the same level. For this reason, the Commission reiterates its request that the fee for the CFPO be set at DCA+15%, i.e. midway between CA and DCA.

ARB has been consulted on this particular topic and they agree that CFPOs should be remunerated at a level higher than DCA.
