

According to the art. 13.7. of the FIDE Charter, "In case of minor violations of the obligations of a Member Federation, or of internal difficulties of a Member Federation that can also directly request its intervention, the Council, following an advisory opinion of the Constitutional Commission, can decide to apply different measures. Among these measures, the following ones are proposed: nomination of a FIDE reverse delegate, nomination of a fact finding commission, nomination of a FIDE special envoy, warning, monitoring and recommendations".

To clarify all practical matters related to the functioning of the Reverse Delegate and similar situations, the Constitutional Commission will develop a more detailed document—a By-Law, in accordance with Article 7.4 of the Charter, which will thoroughly describe all possible scenarios and required actions.
