

Proposed amendment to Article 3.6 of the FIDE Electoral Rules

It is proposed to add the following paragraph to Article 3.6 of the FIDE Electoral Rules:

“Sixty (60) days before the opening date of the General Assembly, each Member Federation may communicate to the FIDE Office, at office@fide.com, the name of its FIDE Delegate's counsellor. After the sixty (60)-day deadline, a Member Federation that has not communicated the name of a FIDE Delegate's counsellor may not nominate a FIDE Delegate's counsellor.

Until thirty (30) days before the opening date of the General Assembly, a Member Federation that has previously communicated the name of its FIDE Delegate's counsellor may communicate the name of a different counsellor, replacing the previously nominated FIDE Delegate's counsellor.. Communications received after the applicable deadlines will not be taken into account.”
