

THE FIDE COUNCIL,

HAVING CONSIDERED the motion to introduce Chess 960 FIDE ratings as outlined in document Annex 5.1.4a, submitted jointly by the German Chess Federation, the Icelandic Chess Federation, the Norwegian Chess Federation, the Irish Chess Union, and the Faroe Islands Chess Federation;

AGREEING with the position that Fischer Random Chess (Chess 960) is actively developing, and its continued growth requires a more dynamic approach, specifically the establishment of an official FIDE rating system;

NOTING, however, that the introduction of such a rating system requires necessary preparatory work, comprehensive planning, and the development of adequate infrastructure;

THEREFORE PROPOSES

that the General Assembly adopt the following resolution:

in accordance with Article 17.2 (h) of the FIDE Statutes (which empowers the General Assembly to express guidelines regarding FIDE activities),

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTS the FIDE Council to develop and, no later than June 1, 2027, approve the official FIDE rating system for Fischer Random Chess (Chess 960)
