AC endeavours to: Communicate its decision in writing as soon as possible after receipt of the appeal. <i>If the appeal procedure causes a delay to the tournament schedule, the next round shall be played as originally planned if $\frac{3}{4}$ of the total number of rounds or fewer have been played. The pairings for the next round shall be done with the result of the disputed game being the result as decided by the Chief Arbiter.</i> <i>If more than $\frac{3}{4}$ of the total number of rounds have been played, the Chief Arbiter shall decide whether or not the next round shall be delayed until the decision of the Appeals Committee has been made.</i>
