A) FIDE DATABASE ENHANCEMENT – FURTHER ACTIONS /1: the Data Protection Committee, considering the increasing numbers of people taking part to the programme approaching the deadline, and the very small number of participants in June-September (as expected in summer) is here proposing to amend FIDE Handbook B.05 and extend the deadline to December 31th, 2021, taking any further action starting from January 1st, 2022.

- 1) So far the database reports 2.682 entries from the 3 different categories, even though some of them are double. A statistic of the entries by day reveals Federations are cooperating, since in different days we receive a big number of entries coming from the same Federation. This cooperation is increasing week by week approaching the deadline.
- 2) Many entries reveal, through the cross-check of birthdays, that in the past many data were incorrect and we are now improving the quality of the database.
- 3) As long as people proceed, we add straightforward their e-mail addresses to the database, which was previously not included.
- 4) The numbers of people asking confirmation of the process because of some mistake in receiving the confirmation e-mail is extremely low (less than 10%). We also have no alarm by any Commission about overwhelming requests for information or clarifications, we were only forwarded by ARB four requests, that we answered immediately.

We hence suggest to extend the deadline and we ask the Management Board to pass the following resolution:

MB01: *prolong B.05 FIDE Database Enhancement to December 31th, 2021, and postpone any subsequent action to 2022.*

And the Council to approve the following amendment to FIDE Handbook B.05:

CO01: *Amend FIDE Handbook B.05 as following:*

Paragraph (1) one: replace 2021/10/31 with 2021/12/31;

Paragraph (5) five: replace 2021/10/31 with 2021/12/31;

Paragraph (6) six: replace 2021/11/01 with 2022/01/01.

B) FIDE DATABASE ENHANCEMENT – FURTHER ACTIONS /2: upon suggestion of MB deputy Chairperson Mrs. Dana Reznice-Ozola DPC held a meeting with Chess in Education Commission (particularly with Mr. O’Connell) where we knew EDU plans to create a database and training / categorisation programme similar to ARB and TRG.

This database has been finished in September 7th, 2021.

This would suggest to extend to them the programme of B.05 FIDE Database Enhancement before they launch the training programme in order not to follow but to precede it.

Mr. O’Connell reported that any new entrant already signs a consent which includes a compliant data protection clause, being the problem the already registered ones.

However, since they are less than one thousand, we are able to involve them in the programme thus making them compliant as well. Mr. O’Connell would be happy to cooperate with Data Protection for such a purpose giving broad information through the Commission website.

Mr. O’Connell also suggests to cover all the title holders with the generic definition of “Chess in Education” due to the variety of their title holders.

That is why we propose to extend the programme to Chess in Education title holders and we ask the Management Board to pass the following resolutions:

MB02: *extend B.05 FIDE Database Enhancement to Chess in Education title holders, ask Data Protection Committee to work together with EDU to include their members to the programme and start it from October 15th, 2021, after a broad information campaign with Federations and the Commission.*

MB03: *add to the FIDE Database Enhancement form one extra option “Chess in Education title holders”.*

And the Council to approve the following amendment to FIDE Handbook B.05:

CO02: *Amend FIDE Handbook B.05 as following:*

Paragraph (1) one: replace the words “and Trainers” with “Trainers and Chess in Education”;

Paragraph (3) three: replace the words “and Trainers” with “Trainers and Chess in Education”;

Paragraph (4) four: replace the words “and Trainers” with “Trainers and Chess in Education”;

Paragraph (6) six: replace the words “and Trainers” with “Trainers and Chess in Education”;


Paragraph (8) eight: replace the words “and Trainers” with “Trainers and Chess in Education”.
