


USAGE OF FUNDS BY FEDERATIONS









CONCLUDING REMARKS- PDC FED FORUM

- 1. Most of the Federations have restrictions because of COVID but, despite that, they are participating in online activities and some of them have been able to organize OTB activities.
- 2. Some Federations have low participation and loss of membership because of COVID. Others have increased participation because of Queen Gambit's effect.
- 3. Federations think that hybrid tournaments is a good opportunity for chess in the continent, even after pandemic; so, they have requested that hybrid tournaments will be valid for titles and norms.
- 4. Besides tournaments, the other main activity is capacity building for arbiters, trainers and organizers. The main social Project is Chess in prison. Few of them named some projects for female players.
- 5. Principal request: Material (chess boards, sets, clocks) and training of trainers and arbiters.
- 6. Although most of the countries think Building Capacity is an important topic for their federation, 24 federations filled out the survey that PDC sent. Follow ups will be done to ensure wider feedback.
- 7. The attendance in PDC Fed Forum decreased in comparison with 2020. This seems to be linked to the contact information not being accurate/up to date which makes it difficult to facilitate more direct communication channels like whatsapp or similar, not only email.





