PROPOSED VOTING ORDER REGARDING THE CHANGES OF THE ARTICLE 18.12. OF THE CHARTER

- 1. Delete Article 18.12. which means to cancel Presidential term limits
- 2. Change Article 18.12. and extend Presidential term limits from the current 2 (8 years) to 4 (16 years)
- 3. Change Article 18.12 and extend Presidential term limits form the current 2 (8 years) to 3 (12 years)

PROCEDURE:

The sequence of the voting would be as follows:

- 1. «To delete Art. 18.12. of the FIDE Charter. To reject other proposals regarding term-limits."
 - Possible voting options: IN FAVOR AGAINST ABSTAIN
 - Only votes IN FAVOR and AGAINST are counted in the final result, 2/3 of the total eligible votes would be needed to consider the proposal approved. If approved, no other voting is needed. If not approved, then the second vote would take place as follows:
- 2. «To amend Art. 18.12. of the FIDE Charter as follows: 18.12 A person cannot serve as FIDE President for more than four terms of four years. Terms may be consecutive or non-consecutive». To reject other proposals regarding term-limits."
 - Possible voting options: IN FAVOR AGAINST ABSTAIN
 - Only votes IN FAVOR and AGAINST are counted in the final result, 2/3 of the total eligible votes would be needed to consider the proposal approved. If approved, no other voting is needed. If not approved, then the second vote would take place as follows:
- 3. «To amend Art. 18.12. of the FIDE Charter as follows: 18.12 A person cannot serve as FIDE President for more than three terms of four years. Terms may be consecutive or non-consecutive». To reject other proposals regarding term-limits."
