Annual Report of the Data Protection Committee

The Data Protection Committee is here sending the following report in order to update the Council of its activity in the year 2020.

1. DAILY MANAGEMENT

- ASSISTANCE TO THE PUBLIC:

The Data Protection Committee runs a daily activity of assistance on privacy matters towards the applicant sending various enquiries to the recipient privacy@fide.com.

Among the various requests there are several data cancellation applications, that require a specific management to verify if the requirements are fulfilled and process them in cooperation with FIDE IT department and Rating Administrator.

There is also a big number of information requests that are processed and replied about any possible privacy-related matter.

All the e-mails normally get an answer within 48 hours, except in the case they require some special check.

E-mails wrongly incoming to privacy@fide.com are forwarded to the right departments.

- ASSISTANCE TO OTHER FIDE ORGANS:

Data Protection normally receives enquiries from other FIDE departments on the right actions to take with regard to matters which may be connected to privacy.

Data Protection had several time advised the Secretariat on specific requests received from external bodies, and the Media department with regard to the FIDE newsletter establishment.

Data Protection has also advised on the content of some drafts of possible agreement in cooperation with FIDE Legal Advisor.

Also in this case all the e-mails normally get an answer within 48 hours, except they require some special check.

2. EXTRAORDINARY MANAGEMENT

- COMPLAINTS FROM REGULATORY AUTHORITIES:

The Finland Regulatory Authority (Data Protection Ombudsman) requested FIDE three times to deliver information upon a complaint sent by Mr. Kimon Nikolakaros, whose data have been cancelled long ago.

The Data Protection Committee is in touch with the Ombudsman and it is resolving the complaint taking the appropriate actions.

- REQUESTS FROM THE ENGLISH POLICE:

Data Protection Committee, in consultation with FIDE Legal Advisor, accomplished an enquiry to deliver data coming from the English Police about a former chess player.

3. NEW PROJECTS

Data Protection Committee has delivered to the Council a package of proposals for the meeting of Sep. 30th which were approved requiring a double check on terminology.

The double check has been run with Mr. Michael Khodarkovsky, Mr. Ilya Gorodetsky and Mr. Vladimir Kukaev and the new text then submitted and approved by the MB, as they are now published on FIDE website.

The enhancement program is technically ready and will start on January, in order to give the Commissions the time to inform their populations.

Data Protection will also solicit feedbacks at his meeting during the Congress.

4. 2021 PROGRAM

The program for the new year is to implement the enhancement and assess the results of the process month by month to see if it works or need any change.

In case of a positive outcome the same program can be launched also for different categories of FIDE populations and even for the general public of players.

The year will also be dedicated to launch the Data Protection Registry, time by time when the enhancement is operating.
